## 2019/2020 Scholarship Opportunities

### Mother St. Andrew Feltin Scholarship

Providence Catholic School (Providence) has secured a special grant for scholarships to be awarded to **new** incoming students who have been accepted for the 2019-2020 school year. Applications and essays must be submitted by May 1, 2019. Mother St. Andrew Feltin Scholarships will be awarded by June 1, 2019.

- **High School Academic Scholarship • Award amount: \$1,000** *One-time, non-renewable award*
  - Must have a GPA of 90% or higher.
  - Provide the first semester report card for the 2018/2019 school year.
  - Provide a personal essay with examples of excellent academic performance, involvement in extracurricular activities, leadership opportunities and community service.
- **Middle School Academic Scholarship • Award amount: \$1,000** *One-time, non-renewable award*
  - Must have an average of 90% or higher.
  - Provide the first semester report card for the 2018/2019 school year.
  - Provide a personal essay with examples of excellent academic performance, involvement in extracurricular activities, leadership opportunities and community service.

### Providence Scholarship Opportunities for grades 6<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup>

- **Academic Scholarship • Award amount: \$400** *One-time, non-renewable award*
  - Criteria: New student takes the Middle School Placement Test by December 8, 2018 and scores two or more grade levels higher than her current grade on both sub-test categories.
  - Priority consideration will be given to students who test at Providence.
  - **To be awarded the scholarship, student must register at Providence no later than February 21, 2019.**

### Providence Scholarship Opportunities for grade 9

- **Bridge Scholarship • Award amount: \$1,000** *One-time, non-renewable award*
  - Awarded to all students attending Providence for the eighth grade (2018-2019) who register to attend Providence as a freshman (2019/2020). The Bridge Scholarship helps bridge the tuition gap between the middle and high school divisions.
- **Moye Academic Excellence Scholarship • Award amount: \$1,000** *One-time, non-renewable award*
  - Awarded to the eighth grade student with the highest cumulative GPA who attended Providence for 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grades and is registered to attend Providence as a freshman in 2019/2020.
- **Academic Scholarship • Award amount: \$4,000** *Awarded annually in the amount of \$1,000*
  - Criteria: 8<sup>th</sup> grade student takes the High School Placement Test (HSPT) by December 8, 2018 and scores at or above the 95<sup>th</sup> percentile.
  - Priority consideration will be given to students who test at Providence.
  - **To be awarded the scholarship, student must register at Providence by February 21, 2019.**
  - Renewability of this scholarship requires that the student maintain a minimum, cumulative GPA of 94.
- **Academic Scholarship • Award amount \$3,200** *Awarded annually in the amount of \$800*
  - Criteria: 8<sup>th</sup> grade student takes the High School Placement Test (HSPT) by December 8, 2018, and scores at or above the 90<sup>th</sup> percentile.
  - Priority consideration will be given to students who test at Providence.
  - **To be awarded the scholarship, student must register at Providence by February 21, 2019.**
  - Renewability of this scholarship requires that the student maintain a minimum, cumulative GPA of 90.

- **Merit Scholarship • Award amount \$750** *One-time, non-renewable scholarship*
  - Criteria: Based on admissions committee review of transcripts, with no grade below a 94 and an 8 or above Stanine Score.
  - **To be awarded this scholarship, student must register at Providence by May 24, 2019.**
- **Merit Scholarship • Award amount \$600** *One-time, non-renewable scholarship*
  - Criteria: Based on admissions committee review of transcripts, with no grade below a 90 and a 7 or above Stanine Score.
  - **To be awarded this scholarship, student must register at Providence by May 24, 2019.**
- **Merit Scholarship • Award amount \$500** *One-time, non-renewable scholarship*
  - Criteria: Based on admissions committee review of transcripts, with no grade below an 85 and a 6 or above Stanine Score.
  - **To be awarded this scholarship, student must register at Providence by May 24, 2019.**

**\*\* In the event that the student is eligible for the Academic and Merit scholarships, she will be awarded only the scholarship with the higher dollar amount. The Mother St. Andrew Feltn Scholarship will not be awarded in conjunction with the Academic or Merit scholarships\*\***

### **Providence Discounts for grades 6<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup>**

- **Alumnae Discount • Amount: \$300** *Annual discount available to 6<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grade students*
  - This scholarship is awarded each student of an alumnae parent. Parent must list “Class of (YEAR)” on the Tuition Payment Contract at time of registration.
- **Sibling Discount • Amount: \$500** *Annual discount available to 6<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grade students*
  - Registered students at Providence who are siblings receive a total of \$500 (a maximum of \$500 per family will be divided by the number of siblings). Sibling name/s must be listed on the Tuition Payment Contract at time of registration.

- **St. Joseph Scholarship for Foster Children • Award amount \$2,500**
  - Middle School student recipient will be determined by need based on the Hope for the Future applications. Scholarships will be determined by **July 2019**.

These scholarships will be renewable for the following year for \$500 provided certain goals are met.
