Scholarships and Assistance Providence Catholic School

2023/2024 Academic Merit Scholarships

Valedictorian/Salutatorian Scholarship for entering grades 6th & 9th

Providence Catholic School is offering a special scholarship to be awarded to new incoming students who are the valedictorian or salutatorian of their 5th or 8th grade class.

- **Moye Academic Excellence Scholarship • Award amount: \$2,500**
 - Awarded to the Providence eighth grade student with the highest cumulative GPA who attended Providence for 6th, 7th, and 8th grades and is registered to attend Providence as a freshman.
 - Eligible for \$1,000/yr. for future high school years if the student maintains a GPA of 94 or higher.
- **High School Valedictorian/Salutatorian • Award amount: \$1,800**
 - Must be the Valedictorian or Salutatorian of their 8th grade class.
 - Must provide their report card for the current school year.
 - Must include documentation of student rank.
 - Eligible for \$1,000/yr. for future high school years if the student maintains a GPA of 97 or higher.
- **Middle School Top of the Class • Award amount: \$1,000**
 - Must have GPA of 97 or higher by the 3rd quarter report card.
 - Must provide their report card for the current school year.
 - Must include documentation of student rank.
 - Eligible for \$750/yr. for future middle school years if the student maintains a GPA of 94 or higher.

Academic Excellence Scholarship – Middle School & High School

Providence Catholic School is offering scholarships to new students who have demonstrated excellence in their academics.

- **High School Academic Excellence Scholarship • Award amount: \$1,200**
 - Must have a GPA of 94 or higher by 3rd quarter report card.
 - Must provide their report card for the current school year.
 - Eligible for \$850/yr. for next 3 years if the student maintains a GPA of 94 or higher.
- **Middle School Academic Excellence Scholarship • Award amount: \$1,000**
 - Must have a GPA of 94 or higher by 3rd quarter report card.
 - Must provide their report card for the current school year.
 - Eligible for \$650/yr. for future middle school years if the student maintains a GPA of 94 or higher.

Academic Merit Scholarships

1. Applicant is required to submit official report card or transcript by the 3rd quarter of the 2022-2023 school year.
2. Academic Merit Scholarships Awarded beginning January 20, 2023 through August 2023 based on Merit.

In the event that the student is eligible for multiple Academic Scholarships, she will be awarded only the scholarship with the higher dollar amount. To be awarded the scholarship, student must be registered at Providence.

- **Bridge Grant • Grant amount: \$1,200**

Discount Opportunities

Discounts are posted after all grants, scholarships and tuition assistance have been applied. Multiple discounts can be applied to the same account, with the higher amount being applied. Annual discounts are available to 6th – 12th grade students

Military Family Discount • Amount: 10%

- Providence Catholic School would like to welcome all Active Military Families and thank them for their service by offering a special discount. Valid Military ID must be provided to the Business Office at time of registration.

Alumnae Discount • Amount: \$500

- This scholarship is awarded to each student of an alumnae parent. Parent must list "Class of (YEAR)" on the Tuition Payment Contract at time of registration.

Sibling Discount • Amount: 15%

- Registered students at Providence who are siblings receive a discount. The oldest student pays full tuition and the second sibling receives a 15% discount. Names must be listed of the Tuition Payment Contract at time of registration.

Catholic Institutions Employee Discounts • Amount: 5%

- Registered students at Providence whose parents are employed at a Catholic Institution in the Archdiocese of San Antonio will receive a 5% discount. Verification of employment must be provided to the Business Office at time of registration.

Mother St. Andrew Feltin Award

Providence Catholic School (Providence) has secured a special grant with the Sisters of Divine Providence for scholarships to be awarded to **new** incoming students who have been accepted for the 2022-2023 school year. Applications and essays must be submitted to qualify for the scholarship at time of registration. A recipient of this scholarship must reapply each year.

- **High School Academic Scholarship • Award amount: \$1,000 One-time.**
 - Must have a GPA of 90% or higher.
 - Provide the first semester report card for the current school year.
 - Provide a personal essay with examples of excellent academic performance, involvement in extracurricular activities, leadership opportunities and community service.
- **Middle School Academic Scholarship • Award amount: \$1,000 One-time.**
 - Must have an average of 90% or higher.
 - Provide the first semester report card for the current school year.
 - Provide a personal essay with examples of excellent academic performance, involvement in extracurricular activities, leadership opportunities and community service.

Providence Catholic School Endowments

- **Hingst Family Tuition Assistance Grant** • Available for high school students only,
 - This grant is possible through the Hingst Endowment. Kathleen Picard Hingst '57 and her husband Ronald A. Hingst, believe in the value of a Catholic education. Mrs. Hingst grew up in a military family and moved often to new schools. She came to Providence as a sophomore, and was grateful to be welcomed so graciously into the Providence family. The generosity of the Hingst's continues to create ripples of Catholic educational opportunity at Providence.
 - Grants distributed based on financial need and are dependent of the availability of funds.
 - Grant recipients are required to submit thank you letters each year receiving funds.
- **Liz Smith Memorial Tuition Assistance Grant** • Available for high school students only
 - Liz Smith came to the Providence family in 1964 being the only lay person on the faculty. She began as a PE teacher, also taught humanities, served as athletic director and eventually became Dean of Students. Dean Smith retired from Providence High School in 1999 with the CDP sisters honoring her service. Former principals and colleagues describe her as a strong woman of Providence with many gifts that she shared with her community. The Liz Smith endowment was established through the donation from her estate and Providence alumnae when she passed April 26, 2021.
 - Grants distributed based on financial need and are dependent of the availability of funds.
 - Grant recipients are required to submit thank you letters each year receiving funds.

Providence Alumnae Association Scholarships

- Providence Catholic School has an active alumnae association who funds several scholarships for students each year.
 - Scholarships are awarded to registered students ONLY.
 - Applications for these scholarships are made available in the Spring semester.

Named Scholarships & Tuition Grants

- Providence Catholic School has several named scholarship in supported by alumnae, past families, or a member of our Providence community.
 - Scholarships are awarded to registered students ONLY.
 - Academic requirements are determined by the Academic Counselors.
 - Need based grants are determined by the Tuition Assistance Committee.
