Pre Order this year's Dig Pink T- shirt to support Providence Volleyball and promote Breast Cancer Awareness.



Provet JROTC Cadets compete in JLAB




Sophomores, Reagan Carlton and Emmanuelle Mefrige competed on the team that took 6th place out of teams from 22 other schools ranging from Dallas to Arizona.

On September 26th, two of our Provets in JROTC competed with the Central Catholic JROTC in an academic competition at the RGV Joint Academic Bowl.

The exam consisted of 30 questions with a time limit of 30 minutes to complete. The cadets were given a 17-hour window to take and submit their answers. The exam questions were extracted from the ASVAB and SAT/ACT Preparation Tools.
